In October 2019, Full Life began conducting activity as a 501(c)(3) non-profit. We hit the ground running and have had many accomplishments along the way. This was all possible thanks to our generous donors and supporters over the past year.

Donations to Date

We've raised over \$29,000 to date from 275 individual donations, 8 charity events and 9 fundraisers. With the funds raised, we donated \$10,000 to establish a perpetual research fund at Columbia University Medical Center to focus on Lynch Syndrome research. The Full Life Foundation for Lynch Syndrome Research Fund will be led by Columbia's Dr. Fay Kastrinos who specializes in cancer genetics.

Supporting Our Community

Full Life is committed to supporting the communities affected by Lynch Syndrome and its related cancers. In addition to our \$10,000 donation to support research, Full Life has donated over \$2,000 to the following institutions and community organizations.

- 100+ meals donated to healthcare workers on the frontlines of COVID-19
- Catered lunch & entertainment for patients receiving cancer treatment at The American Cancer Society's Hope Lodge
- The FLF team participated and raised funds for Columbia's Cancer Center through their annual Velocity Day event
